When a pediatrician walks into an exam room with a children's book in hand, it changes everything.

Nestled - or more often wiggling - in their parent's arms, their eyes light up, following along with the characters, identifying colors and objects, using fine motor skills as they turn the pages.

In these visits, families receive a prescription for reading. Caregivers and medical professionals become partners in making reading a part of the daily routine, forging strong relationships and lasting memories. The building blocks of literacy, connection, and joy begin here and in every subsequent well child visit.

While the challenges of the pandemic still impact our community, 2021 was a year of resilience and renewed hope. Businesses reopened, students returned to the classroom, and families were welcomed back into their pediatricians' offices to receive their cherished books from Reach Out and Read of Greater New York (ROR GNY).

2021 HIGHLIGHTS




IN 2021 ROR GNY PROUDLY:

- distributed 303,495 books
- served 251,703 children
- parterned with 230 medical centers and 726 trained medical providers

- Hosted quarterly medical provider Town Halls
- Partnered with NY H+H Test and Trace Corps to distribute 38,000 books at COVID-19 testing sites in all five boroughs
- Hosted virtual Literacy Conferences in March and June
- Provided 75,000 free log-ins to Vooks for 3-5-year-olds in our program
- Hosted 21 virtual workshops on topics including creating a graphic novel, social emotional development, and child nutrition
- Collaborated with 10 literacy partners to purchase a bulk book order through the Book Buddies initiative to secure diverse books at a lower cost
- Launched and created 19 videos for "Beyond the Book", a series featuring activities to engage with a chosen book
- Continued virtual Read Alouds on Facebook on Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays with 150 Read Alouds in 2021




In 2021, our team built a brand new coalition with other literacy organizations to increase our collective purchasing power for better pricing on diverse books.

WELL CHILD VISITS BY RACE




